Contests are open to all poets. State name of contest on envelope. Entry Fee: **\$3.00/poem** (except for NPD Contest*), payable to M.S.P.S. Only US Money order check or US currency is accepted – **No** Foreign Country check or currency. If M.S.P.S. is fined for checks that are cancelled due to insufficient funds, the poet must **reimburse M.S.P.S.** Poems that had won a prize are disqualified and any award money must be **returned to M.S.P.S.** Poets may enter as many poems as they wish but only one prize may be won by any poet. Poems must be typed. Send 2 copies of each entry, one with no I.D. (for the judge) and one with **name, address, email address or tel. #. RULES

- 1. **DEADLINE**: August 1, 2024. Entries must be mailed via USPS, postmarked by Aug. 1, 2024.
- 2. ENTRY FEE: Single fee for the entire contest -

\$15 for NON-MEMBERS \$10 for M.S.P.S. MEMBERS CHECK PAYABLE TO M.S.P.S., INC.

- 3. Poems submitted must:
 - a. Be the poet's original work.
 - b. Be *unpublished* and *not entered* currently in any other contest.
 - c. Have *not* won a prize in *any* contest.
 - d. Be **typed** (minimum font **12** pt.) on 8-1/2" x 11" white paper, portrait orientation.
 - e. Be titled (except haiku).
 - f. Not have illustrations
- 4. Only **ONE** poem may be entered in each category.
- 5. NO poem may be entered in more than one category.
- 6. No poem will be returned.
- 7. Prize money received for disqualified poems must be returned.
- Only one prize for each contest entered.
 a. Only 3 prizes per categories. No HMs no ties.
- 9. M.S.P.S. will **cancel** any category with **less than 6 entries**, and the sponsor will be notified.
- 10. Prepare original and copy as follows:

ON BOTH COPIES: Put contest number and contest name in upper LEFT-HAND corner. ON DUPLICATE ONLY: Put poet's name, street & email address, telephone # in upper RIGHT-HAND corner.
